NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN: That the Village of Corfu Board of Trustees will be holding a Public Hearing on Monday, July 28, 2014 at 6:30 pm at Community Center at 116 East Main Street, Corfu, NY regarding renewal of the cable television franchise agreement by and between the Village of Corfu and Time Warner Cable.

A copy of the agreement is available for public inspection during normal business hours at the Village Clerk's office at 116 East Main Street, Corfu, NY. At such public hearing all persons will be given an opportunity to be heard. Written and oral statements will be taken at that time. Time limitations may be imposed for each oral statement if necessary.

BOARD CONNECTION

Deputy Mayor Dave Bielec continues to run the Village board meetings and Trustee Art Ianni is supervising the Police department in the absence of a Mayor. The Board has determined to continue with a four member Board until the March 2015 elections, at which time a new Mayor would be elected. We would like to extend a thank you to the village residents who have been attending village meetings and offering their assistance on committees. It is a pleasure to have so many residents show an interest in the village.

MAINTENANCE:

The Village Board would like to announce that Jay Feitshans term of employment ended on May 31, 2014. The Board would like to thank Jay for his service with the Village. The Board has hired Theresa Reynolds as a seasonal worker, to work alongside Jesse Stocking.

We would like to commend Jesse Stocking, Norm Waff and Al Graham for their work on the Sewer Project. We do realize that in some instances brush pickup has been delayed due to the Project. We want to thank the Village residents for their patience when those delays have occurred.

COMMITTEE NEWS:

The "Celebration and Beautification Committee" is already focusing on the upcoming Winterfest in January of 2015. Application will be made for financial assistance through GoArt and other possible sources are being explored. Trustee Ianni has set a meeting for Wednesday, July 23rd at 6:30 pm at the Community Center to begin working on plans.

This committee will also be looking forward to 2018 when the Village celebrates 150 years of being incorporated. Village Historian, Al Starkweather is willing to work with those interested in setting up a 2018 Sesquicentennial celebration. If anyone is interested please contact the Village Office.

SEWER PROJECT:

The Sewer Project is moving along well. The Town will begin hooking in laterals for the Town users around August 1st. The Sewer Agreement between the Village and Town is being finalized.

The work at the Corfu Plant is nearing completion. Village of Corfu maintenance and Camden Group have been working alongside the contractors and electricians, and all that remains are punch lists and clean up. This has been a perfect example of working together with the Town of Pembroke for the good of the community. POLICE:

The Village Police are now part of the CSEA Local 1000 Union. The Board is attempting to schedule a meeting with the Union for negotiations.

GRANT INFO:

In the Spring issue of the Village newsletter we were pleased to announce that the Village has been awarded \$4,835.50 for a JCAP grant which was submitted by the Village Court for a security system that would benefit both the Village and Town Offices. The security system has now been installed and is working well.

HISTORICAL HIGHLIGHTS BY AL

Historical Tidbits!

- On August 27, 1891, the Buffalo Courier Express reported that Leonard Wagner of Corfu had called a Buffalo Police Station looking for lodging for the night. Mr. Wagner had left Corfu that morning with \$7.00 and had gone to Buffalo to get his watch from a pawn shop. He had pawned it a few days earlier. He got his watch back, then decided to celebrate. Mr. Wagner pawned the watch again, but soon was penniless again and called the Police department again. No word if the Police gave him a room for the night.
- In 1911, Paul Giddings of Corfu signed to play professional baseball for the Mansfield, Ohio team in the Ohio-Pennsylvania League. He has previously played for the Batavia Team in the WNY League.
- In February of 1939 an acting group from the Corfu Grange won a regional competition and was one of four groups to go to Ithaca to compete for the NYS Championship. No group was named the winner. They just called them "The four best acting groups in New York State". The Corfu group performed "The Blue Tea Cup".
- On May 30, 1953, The "War Memorial" in front of the Corfu School (Intermediate School on Allegheny) was dedicated in a Memorial Day Ceremony.
- The Village election in 1962 was all "write-in" ballots. There were two Trustee positions to be filled. The Republicans failed to hold a caucus and by State Law "went out of existence". The Democrats did not nominate anyone for the two Trustee positions. Therefore, all votes had to be by write-in ballots. Two Republicans were elected with write-in votes.
- In May of 1909, the Daily News reported that four new automobiles had been purchased in Corfu. There were now 10 "Whiz Wagons" in Corfu.

Thanks to all of you who stopped by the Pembroke history booth at the "Freedom Tribute Wall" at the Town Park. The wall was quite a memorable event for our Town and something to be proud of.
