



Village of Corfu Regular Meeting August 26, 2020

The Village of Corfu Mayor held the Monthly Regular Meeting at the Corfu Village Hall, 116 East Main Street on August 26, 2020 at 6:30 p.m. Present were Deputy Mayor Graham, Trustee Lauer, Trustee Reisdorf, Trustee Doktor, Village Clerk, Jennifer Eck. Mayor Sargent, Farmer's Market representatives, Katie Hobbs and Matthew Steinberg, Planning Board Chairman, Mark Zimmerman.

Planning Update:
