



Village of Corfu Committee Meeting September 23, 2020

The Village of Corfu Board held its Monthly Committee Meeting at the Corfu Village Hall, 116 East Main Street on September 23, 2020 at 6:30 p.m. Present were Mayor Sargent, Deputy Mayor Graham, Trustee Lauer, Trustee Reisdorf, Trustee Doktor, Village Clerk, Jennifer Eck, and Planning Board Chairman, Mark Zimmerman.

The meeting was opened at 6:30 pm followed by the Pledge to the Flag.

Planning Update:

- Trustee Reisdorf questioned the amount of sheds on a property on Longs Lane
- Planning Board Chairman Mark Zimmerman has been in contact with Felipe Oltramari with Genesee County Planning and with Attorney John Whiting. He questioned what specific properties are being considered for re-zoning. He is trying to come up with a procedure and will contact attorney. Mayor Tom Sargent asked how feasible is this for the village to do.
- Planning Board is going through the old code book to review and update.

Police Update:

- Mayor Sargent informed the Board that Officer Labelle is in FTO training; he is very involved with community

Court Update:

- Received \$15,334.00 for August 2020 Fines
- Trustee Reisdorf reviewed court audit results with the Board; Court Clerk will contact NYS OSC regarding the Bail money in question
- John Whiting will send Audit review to NYS Magistrates Office

Maintenance Update:

- Deputy Mayor Graham informed the Board they will be getting delivery of truck in a couple weeks; maintenance needs to continue to use the old truck due to leaf season, will discuss once new truck gets delivered
- Discussed dumpster days; not a big turnout like usual however, many people coming after hours for the drop off. Fence should be installed prior to next year's roll off.
- Mr. Eck is working on the paperwork to add Fieldcrest to the Chips list

Office Update:

- Clerk is attending NYCOM fall training virtually
- Clerk informed Trustees of the Election results; Trustee Lauer and Trustee Reisdorf will take their oaths of office after this meeting

- Clerk informed the Board there is a lack of election inspectors in the Village; Clerk has reached out to Board of Elections for options
