



## Village of Corfu Regular & Year End Meeting Minutes May 26, 2021

The Village of Corfu Mayor and Board of Trustees held the Committee & Year End Meeting at the Corfu Village Hall, in the Corfu Fire Dept Meeting room, 116 East Main Street on May 26, 2021, at 6:30 p.m. Present were Mayor Sargent, Deputy Mayor Doktor, Trustee Lauer, Trustee Reisdorf, Trustee Johnson, Village Clerk, Jennifer Eck, and Village Electrician, Norm Waff, Camden Group Representative, Glenn Eck, Planning Board Chairmen, Mark Zimmerman.

### Planning Update:

- Mr. Zimmerman reviewed the survey conducted throughout the Village, 23 answered the survey.
- Site plan for Booze Barn has been approved, Zoning and Code Enforcement Officer to complete a formal inspection for the Board.

### Police Update:

- Officer in Charge, Mr. Krzemien gave Police update:
  - o Working on Police survey; have received 90 responses.
  - o Since January
    - 743 Tickets written, 569 were speeding tickets.
    - 109 Complaints answered throughout Village.
    - 12 Assists to State/County calls.
    - 14 Cars impounded.
    - 860 Business/Resident checks.
  - o New Officer has completed FTO.
  - o Darien Lake is now open, Sheriff Department and NYS Police are assisting with Security detail.
  - o Discussed traffic flow issues at Intermediate School.
  - o Taser has not been purchased at this time, did receive quote for \$2,200 with 4 cartridges.

**Sewer Update:**

- Mayor Sargent is continuing to work on the agreement with Town of Pembroke and the IMA- inter-municipal agreement to combine as one sewer plant.
- Discussion about grant, engineers, attorney, and accountant must continue to work on grants for this project.
- Intermunicipal agreements must be completed and turned into the State, Corfu must stay as the user.
- Camden Group has presented a 1-year contract.

- Discussion about shutting down the Corfu plant and starting it up periodically until the town starts sending more flow.
- Trustee Lauer was concerned about the plan that has not been submitted from Camden group as to how and what maintenance will need to be done on the Corfu plant while shut down also, the number of repairs that will need to be completed.
- Mr. Waff informed the Board the new heaters that were installed last fall are in violation of the electrical code and contractor, Thomas Underwood needs to fix this matter. Mayor will contact Camden Group Manager, Al Graham to have the heaters moved.
- It was decided to table the Camden 1-year contract until plan has been submitted.

Beautification Update:

- Deputy Mayor Doktor has completed the flowerpot project.
- Flags will be installed this week with help from the Honor’s Society.
- Deputy Mayor Doktor is planning on Village wide yard sale, will advertise this on Facebook.
- Discussing a possible survey to plan for Autumn in the Village, will also reach out to the Church.
- Deputy Mayor Doktor informed the Board there was a Breach in the Better Corfu Facebook page, this issue has been resolved.
- Discussed traffic control and looking for Volunteer’s for Farmer’s Market.

Trustee Johnson made a motion to go into Executive Session to discuss Police Department at 7:50 pm; 2<sup>nd</sup> by Trustee Reisdorf. Both Village and Deputy Clerk left the meeting.
